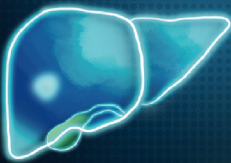

Method of Payment

Payment of the registration fee should be made by:

Cancellation Policy

Registration cancellations notified with **a written notice received by Event Secretariat on or before 30th September 2025 at 23:59 (GMT +8), will be subjected to a 25% administration fee.** After this date, no refund can be made for cancellation.

A notice shall be deemed to have been received by the Event Secretariat: if delivered personally to the reception counter of the Hong Kong College of Radiologists, at 09:00 (GMT +8) on the day after posting; if delivered by commercial courier, on the date and at the time that the courier's delivery receipt is signed; or, if sent by fax or email, 24 hours after transmission.
Please note that all refunds will be issued only after the meeting.

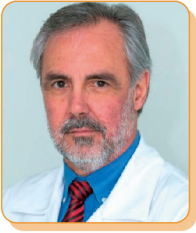

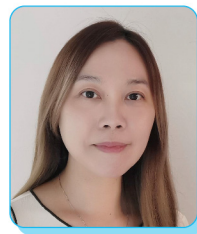

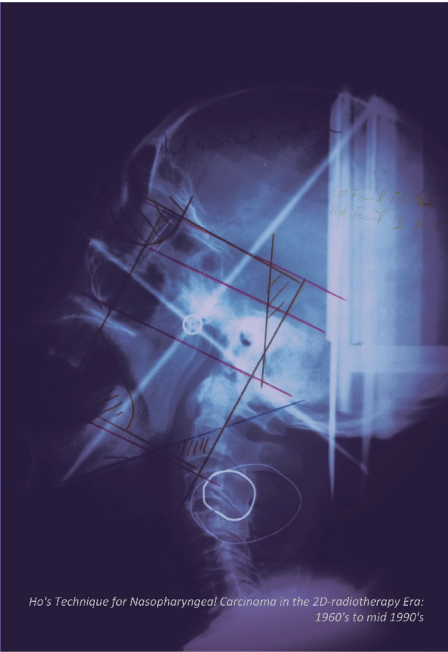
